March will be spent getting ready to enter The Mystery of Easter. We'll use the color purple, which is the color of preparation, as the underlay for our stories, our Focal Shelf, and our Gratitude Circle. On the first Sunday of Lent, the students heard a story about how Lent is a time to get to know more about the One who is Easter, as well as a time to get to know more about who we really are. They heard how Easter changes the color of preparation to the color of pure celebration (white), turning everything inside out and upside down, and it takes a long time to get ready for it. The stories we'll tell this month are the seven Faces of Easter, which highlight important parts of Jesus' life and journey toward the cross.
